

GMO POLICY STATEMENT



Loughran Brewers Select fully appreciates public and customer concerns over the possible risks and dangers of growing, harvesting and use of genetically modified materials, and it is these concerns that are paramount.

All barley, wheat, maize and other adjunct that is currently used on our site is produced using traditional plant breeding techniques.

Those varieties in use have been developed by plant breeders from long-established malting or baking varieties.

Loughran Brewers Select monitors research and development that is taking place, in order to stay properly informed and to have the knowledge to understand and evaluate potential risks and advantages that may result from the use of genetically modified materials.

Loughran Brewers Select products are not:

- Produced from genetically modified raw materials.
- Produced from any raw materials derived from genetically modified products
- In contact with any genetically modified organisms or any raw materials containing genetically modified organisms during the manufacturing process.
- Produced using any additives or processing aids derived from genetically modified organisms.

The main raw materials used by Loughran Brewers Select are barley grains which are sourced predominantly within the UK. No genetically modified strains of these cereals are commercially available within the EU.

Loughran Brewers Select products are not subject to any additional labelling in compliance of the regulations (EC) Nos. 1829/2003 and 1830/2003.

The owners, directors and senior management team of Loughran Brewers Select recognises the need to maintain an effective dialogue with other companies and interested parties in the malting, brewing, distilling and food industries.
